

Meeting Room Rental

Based on the space requirements outlined above, the room rental fee of \$134.000 will be reduced to \$60,000. Rental fees will be reduced by \$1.00 for every \$3.00 spent in catered events. Maximum rental reduction will be \$30.000.

Finally, there's a high-quality, high-service, high-tech center for trade shows, conventions, training sessions, corporate meetings and social events alike. It's the brand-new Overland Park Convention Center and it will open your eyes to new possibilities in successful meetings and events.

"This facility provides a new option for groups seeking the right fit for their size of meeting or convention," comments Jerry Cook, president of the Overland Park Convention and Visitors Bureau. "Our geographical location, infrastructure, accessibility, proximity of an excellent inventory of hotel rooms, at-ease parking, and high quality personal service positions the Overland Park Convention Center as a natural choice for our guests."

The \$46.5-million, full-service convention center is the realization of a dream that began two decades ago when city officials first proposed the idea of building a first-class facility in the suburbs of Kansas City. The center opened its doors in November 2002, offering 237,000 square feet of meeting, exhibition, banquet, pre-function, and service space. A football-field size outdoor courtyard connects a 20-story, 412-room Sheraton Hotel to the Convention Center offering over 20,000 square feet of additional event space.


The convention center sits on a 26-acre site at the corner of College Boulevard and Lamar Avenue in the heart of Overland Park, the largest suburban city in the Kansas City metro area. It features a 60,000-square-foot exhibition hall, a 25,000-square-foot ballroom, 15,000 square feet of meeting space, and 44,000 square feet of registration and pre-function space. A movable soundproof wall separates the ballroom and exhibition hall with a service corridor between the two rooms. When the walls are removed, nearly 90,000 square feet of exhibition space are available to meeting and convention groups.

The design of the two-story convention center includes a dramatic ninestory glass tower, which is illuminated at night and serves as the signature architectural feature of the new facility. Other features inside the center include extremely wide corridors, ample natural light, and over 130 pieces of attractive artwork from regional artists.

The center features state-of-the-art technology with high-speed Internet access and outlets for audio-visual connections and multimedia presentations in the meeting rooms and exhibition hall. A complete inhouse food service operation is available. Parking is complimentary and includes 957 spaces with 225 covered.



Transportation/Geographics

Overland Park sit approximately 1,900 miles from each coast and is the most geographically centered metro in the nation.



Land

Overland Park is served by one of the best freeway networks in the country, helping to keep commute times short.


Overland Park's access to the region's freeway system is unsurpassed with four major freeways, I-35, I-435, I-635 and US 69 passing through the city. No location in Overland Park is more than 3 1/2 miles from a freeway.

Air

Air travelers will find Overland Park to be well served. KCI (Kansas City International) is only 25 miles north of Overland Park and is easily accessible via either of two alternate freeway routes.

Overland Park is also directly served by Johnson County Executive Airport which provides complete sevices for private business jet operators as well as for general aviation.

In addition, New Century AirCenter just 12 miles southwest of the city also provides general aviation services and can accommodate cargo or passenger jets of any size.
