9 DAYS VISITING TOKYO, MT. FUJI, HIROSHIMA, KYOTO AND OSAKA

Remarkable Journey with Ken Smookler



Day 1 Sep 3 Arrive in Tokyo from Yokohama (Dinner)

Transfer from Yokohama to Tokyo by coach. Group dinner with Ken Smookler and other tour members at hotel or a local restaurant. Accommodation at Shingawa Prince Hotel for 2 nights

Day 2 Sep 4 Tokyo (Breakfast/Lunch)

Your day starts with a tour of Tokyo Meiji Shrine. Then you will continue on to the Imperial Palace Plaza and the Asakusa Kannon Temple, which is the oldest and most famous temple in Tokyo with a harmonious melding of design and spirituality. You will stop at the Nakamise area for shopping. Buffet lunch en-route included.

Day 3 Sep 5 Tokyo –Mt. Fuji (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Visit sacred Mount Fuji, the highest mountain in Japan and recognized as one of the most beautiful volcanoes in the world. After lunch at Highland Resort you will proceed to Hakone for a cruise on Lake Ashi, followed by a ride on Mt. Komagatake Aerial Cableway. Check in Palace Hotel Hakone or similar.

Day 4 Sep 6 Mt. Fuji –Hiroshima by JR train (Breakfast)

Pick up from hotel to Odawara train station for your onward journey to Hiroshima on a bullet train. Lunch box on the train on your own expense. Upon arrival, met and transferred to Hiroshima New Hiroden Hotel or similar.

Day 5 Sep 7 Hiroshima-Miyajima (Breakfast/Lunch)

Visit the colorful Miyajima Shrine with its red Torii Gate seemingly afloat in the sea and then to Peace Memorial Park with its museum of the A-Bomb devastation relics, photos and data.

Day 6 Sep 8 Hiroshima-Kyoto by JR train (Breakfast/Lunch)

Morning transfer by train to Kyoto. After lunch, tour to Nara, the first permanent capital of Japan. Visit Todaiji Temple housing a great image of Buddha, colorful Kasuga Shrine with 3,000 lanterns, and Deer Park where many tame deer are freely roaming. Return to Kyoto and check into : Kyoto Karasuma Hotel or similar

Day 7 Sep 9 Kyoto (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, have one-day city tour including the Golden Pavilion, Nijo Castle noted for its gorgeous interiors, (If Nijo Castle is closed, visit Ryoanji Temple instead) and Lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch, move on to Sanjusangendo Hall with its 1,001 impressive images of Buddha, vermilion-hued Heian Shrine and Kiyomizu Temple. In the evening, enjoy an authentic, relaxing tea ceremony and a Zen-style Tempura Dinner.

Day 8 Sep 10 Kyoto –Osaka by coach (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Transfer by coach to Osaka in the morning and have a short half-day sightseeing tour including the New Umeda City, Aerial Garden Observatory and Osaka Castle. Check into Osaka Rihga Nakanoshima Inn or similar.

Day 9 Sep 11 Osaka –Home City (Breakfast)

Pick up at a pre-arranged time transfer from your hotel to Osaka Kansai Airport for your return flight home. Tour ends.
